

GIPSA's Export Grain Quality Report Available

WASHINGTON, D.C. (March 11, 1999)--The USDA Grain Inspection, Packers and Stockyards Administration (GIPSA) today released its latest report on the quality of U.S. grain exports.

Published annually, GIPSA's "1998 U.S. Grain Exports: Quality Report" summarizes the quality of export wheat, corn, soybeans, sorghum, barley, sunflower seeds, oats, and canola.
