

Lee Johnson Suspended as a Registrant for Six Years

WASHINGTON, April 30, 2009 - On April 15, 2009, the U.S. Department of Agriculture's Grain Inspection, Packers and Stockyards Administration entered into a decision without hearing by reason of default with Lee Johnson (Johnson), Montalba, Texas.

Johnson has been ordered to cease and desist from failing to pay the full amount for livestock purchases.

Johnson is suspended from operating under the Packers and Stockyards (P&S) Act for a period of six years.

The P&S Act is a fair trade practice and payment protection law that promotes fair and competitive marketing environments for the livestock, meat, and poultry industries.
