Foreword

The Grain Inspection, Packers and Stockyards Administration, Federal Grain Inspection Service, provides plant sanitation inspections under the authority of the Agricultural Marketing Act of 1946, as amended, and under Program Directive 906.2, Implementation of the FGIS-FDA Memorandum of Understanding. The Sanitation Handbook provides policies and procedures for this service.

This handbook is revised to authorize field office managers to delegate licensees or samplers to perform sanitation inspections at certain locations, clarify some procedures, put in new format, and make minor editorial changes.

This handbook replaces the Sanitation Inspection Handbook dated 12/1/75.
