Effective Date: October 13, 2016 Federal Grain Inspection Service (FGIS) must approve all fees for official services and official agencies will assess only those fees appearing on their current approved fee schedule

Regular Hours: 7:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Monday thru Friday **EXCEPT** holidays.

Regular, Standby, Travel, Overtime, Sunday, & Holiday Hourly Rates: Assessed in half-hour increments.

Inspectors/Sampler

Regular.....	\$20.00
Saturday & other than regular weekly hours.....	\$30.00
Sunday & Holidays.....	\$40.00

Standby/Travel, above applicable rate applies. Overtime & Holiday rates applied in addition to unit fees. Holidays include New Year's Day, Memorial Day, and July 4th, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day, & Christmas Day.

Check testing of on-site equipment, DT Samplers, and Power probes will have an applicable hourly rate

Hastings Grain Inspection reserves the right to determine the number of inspection personnel to properly service the customer.

Mileage Rate: IRS standard rate will be assessed for actual miles traveled outside Grand Island and Hastings city limits by full-time or part-time personnel. Any change to the mileage rate is effective when the IRS changes their standard mileage rate.

Intermittent Onsite Lab Service: Carrier or sample fee, applicable travel and mileage plus overnight lodging cost when required to remain away from inspection point.

Official Services: Official grading and factor only unit fees, sampling **NOT** included **EXCEPT** as indicated.

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AMA FEE SCHEDULE

Services Performed under Agricultural Marketing Act of 1946
(Fees include GIPSA-FGIS user fee)

Effective Date

July 1, 2015

Regular Hours

Monday through Friday from 7:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. All hourly rates assessed in half-hour increments per individual necessary to perform the service and a minimum of 2 hours per person will be assessed.

Regular Hourly Rate

\$30.00

Overtime Hourly Rate

One and one-half times regular hourly rate. Applies to Saturday and other than regular hours. Minimum of 4 hours per person is assessed for Saturday, Sunday, and holidays worked.

Sunday and Holiday Hourly Rate

Double the regular hourly rate. Holidays include; New Year's Day, Memorial Day, July 4th, Labor Day, Thanksgiving, and Christmas.

Mileage

The IRS standard mileage rate will be assessed per mile actual miles traveled. Any change to the mileage rate is effective when the IRS changes their standard mileage rate. Mileage and travel time will be prorated when it is possible.

Travel

Airfare and other related expenses will be assessed at actual cost. Per Diem will be assessed at \$25.00 per day.

Inspection Services

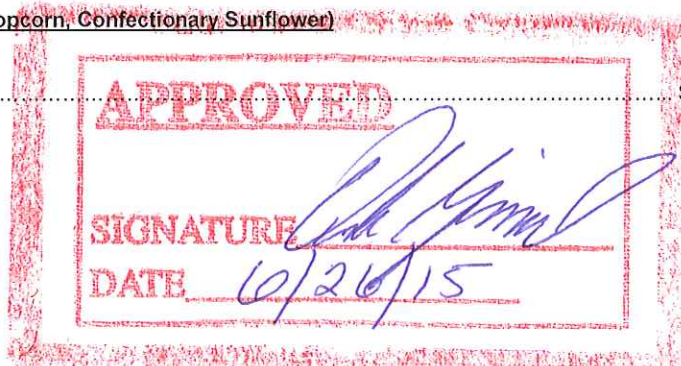
