Agricultural Marketing Act (AMA)

Edible Beans

Effective date: March 1, 2014. This fee schedule is issued by New Mexico Department of Agriculture. The Federal Grain Inspection Service (FGIS) must approve all fees for official services and official agencies will assess only the fees appearing on their current approved fee schedule.

This external policy establishes inspection fees for Edible Beans effective March 1, 2014.

Under the authority of the Produce Marketing Act [76-15-10 to 76-15-22, NMSA 1978], NMDA is Authorized to establish and collect fee for Edible Bean sampling, grading, weighing and certification.

Per Diem Charge: If agency personnel are required to stay out overnight while providing inspection services, applicable New Mexico State Per Diem and Mileage Act[10-8-4, NMSA 1978] will be assessed per employee.

Hourly Rate (Monday through Friday): \$35.00 per hour. Sampling, grading, weighing and certification are included in the hourly rate. A minimum call out fee of 2 hours will be assessed per employee unless the request for service is cancelled 1 hour prior to departure for applicant's facility.

Overtime Rate: (Saturday, Sunday and Holidays): \$17.50 per hour plus regular hourly rate or a special charge to cover the inspector's overtime rate. There is a four hour minimum charge on weekends and holidays.

Travel Time and Standby Time: Assessed at the applicable hourly rate. Stand-by time is accrued when agency personnel are at the worksite and available to work but are unable to; due to customer delays.

Stowage/Checkloading Exam Fees:

Railcar: \$10.00 per car

Truck/Trailer:\$10.00 per truck/trailer

Container: \$10.00 per container

In the event that a state or federal marketing agreement, marketing order, or commodity commission requires an inspection program, the director/secretary is authorized to negotiate an inspection fee for such a program. Whenever it is anticipated that scheduled fees will not cover all costs, an appropriate charge will be made, and at no time will the charge be less than the equivalent scheduled fee. The director/secretary of NMDA is authorized to determine assessments for these special circumstances.

Aflatoxin Testing Fee: \$30.00 per sample

Factor only determination, per factor:\$5.00

Miscellaneous Fees: Special Handling/Sending samples to third party labs at request of customer: Applicable hourly rate, plus shipping and mileage charge.

Additional Statement: \$3.00 per statement

Duplicate Certificate copies: \$3.00 per copy

Other Official Services not covered above: Applicable hourly rate, plus supplies and equipment.
