GRAIN INSPECTION FEES AND CHARGES

Effective Date: July 1, 2016. The Federal Grain Inspection Service (FGIS) must approve all fees for official services and OAs will assess only those fees appearing on their current approved fee schedule. State and local taxes will be added as required.

Regular Hours and Hourly Rates: New Jersey Office: 7:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. (first 8 hours within regular hours) Monday through Friday, except Holidays. Assessed in quarter-hour increments, per individual necessary to perform the service, in addition to unit fees. Includes all sampling methods, weighing and onsite grading.

Inspector/Sampler/Weigher: \$42.80 per hour

Overtime Hours: One and one-half times the regular hourly rate for work performed on Saturday and other than regular hours, assessed in quarter-hour increments, in addition to unit fees.

Holiday and Sunday Hourly Rates: Double the regular hourly rate, assessed in quarter-hour increments, in addition to unit fees. Holidays include: New Year's Day, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day, Christmas Day, and after 12:00 p.m. on Christmas Eve Day and New Year's Eve Day.

Callout Time: A minimum of 4 hours per person will be assessed at the applicable hourly rate when requests for service are withdrawn or in the event of request resulting in personnel returning to duty after dismissal.

Travel Time: Assessed per individual at applicable hourly rate.

Mileage: The Internal Revenue Service standard rate will be the maximum assessed for actual miles driven, prorated whenever possible. Any change to the mileage rate is possible when the IRS changes their standard mileage rate.

AGRICULTURAL MARKETING FEES AND CHARGES

Effective Date: January 1, 2015. The Federal Grain Inspection Service (FGIS) must approve all fees for official services and OAs will assess only those fees appearing on their current approved fee schedule. State and local taxes will be added as required.

Regular Hours and Hourly Rates: New Jersey Office: 7:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. (first 8 hours within regular hours) Monday through Friday, except Holidays. Assessed in quarter-hour increments, per individual necessary to perform the service, in addition to unit fees. Includes all sampling methods, weighing and onsite grading.

Inspector/Sampler/Weigher \$42.80 per hour

Overtime Hours: One and one-half times the regular hourly rate for work performed on Saturday and other than regular hours, assessed in quarter-hour increments, in addition to unit fees.

Holiday and Sunday Hourly Rates: Double the regular hourly rate, assessed in quarter-hour increments, in addition to unit fees.
